and give our lives to you, from whom nothing in us is hidden.

All You are before us, God, you are behind.

You are around us, God, you are within.

All We bring the faith that is in us, and the doubt.

We bring the joy that is in us, and the sorrow.

Leader O God of life, you are in the light and in the darkness.

All We bring the knowing that is in us, and the unknowing.
